Hanadi sbc was incorporated on November 18, 2017 as a specific benefit corporation that pursues the following purpose: to educate people about Islam in order to establish a better understanding of the Muslim community in America and help eliminate the well-endorsed hate through public speaking, consulting and media intervention for an accurate portrayal of Muslims in the mainstream media. Here's a progress report on the covered period:

1) From the end of 2017 till the end of 2018 we have been able to:

(i) Work with more clients who are seeking to hear about the experience of being Muslim in America and learning about ways to be mindful and supportive of their Muslim constituents. Among those clients: The Federal Bureau of Investigation, Steel County Historical Society, St Mary's Basilica, Great River School, Multicultural National Women's Conference, Leadership Diversity Alliance, Clockwork, Mentoring methods, The Islamophobia conference, MYLA, Children's hospital, Wells Fargo and Serious Play conference. The nature of the engagement was mostly by keynoting but also included panels, trainings and articles. The size of the audience for each event varied between 27 to 2,000 people as was the case of St Mary's Basilica on 'Immigrant day' gathering. Additional facilitation efforts have taken place with The Islamic Center of Minnesota event on "mental health awareness". One event with American Association of University Women (AAUW) was cancelled because of extreme weather conditions.

(ii) Hanadi sbc continues its relentless efforts to dispel myths and create conversations and build bridges within our various communities. We have been able to reach suburban communities in Hudson and Owatonna and out-of-state conferences in New York, Buffalo and San Diego in additional to a massive digital audience with HR.com. We have been able to create more positive stories in the media with:

One of the most concerted efforts we've done this year is to accept the role of being the "Diversity Watch" offered by Susan Rocco on her CBS Radio show, Women to Watch. Starting September of 2018, we have been airing weekly two-minutes-segment relaying prophetic ethics that Muslims believe in and live by, as a way to foster competence and understanding among the general public of Muslims' ethics and lifestyle. The project will include 52 segments in a one year period.

(iii) The word is out and clients are reaching out to know more. The biggest challenge at this point is getting more paid speaking requests and consultancy projects to insure the sustainability of my business. The work load includes a lot of networking, communicating and following-up. Administrative help is needed but cannot be supported at this point.
