Benefit Stated in Articles

PIANOCYCLE, SBC relocates and/or recycles acoustic pianos located in the United States of America in order to maximize positive impact and minimize environmental damage on a global scale.

(i) the ways in which the corporation pursued and created the specific public benefit stated in its articles;

PIANOCYCLE began picking up acoustic pianos from homes in the Twin Cities starting in September of 2018. Pianos picked up were either:

- i) Given away to local families
- ii) Recycled

Families receiving a free piano must pay an \$88 delivery fee. Extra charges apply for interior stairs, tight turns, and distances greater than 20 miles from Minneapolis.

Pianos that no longer function must be broken down in order for the wood and metal to be separated.

Wood

Approximately 50% of the wood by weight from a piano can be separated and given away for various

woodworking and creative projects. These parts typically include: piano front, kneeboard, fallboard, soundboard, backposts, keys.

Metal

Approximately 99% of the metal by weight is separated and recycled from all pianos that no longer function. Strings, tuning pins, and screws are removed and sorted by metal type. The cast iron plate is also removed and recycled.

PIANOCYCLE, SBC recycled forty-eight (48) and relocated five (5) acoustic pianos in the Twin Cities area in 2018.
