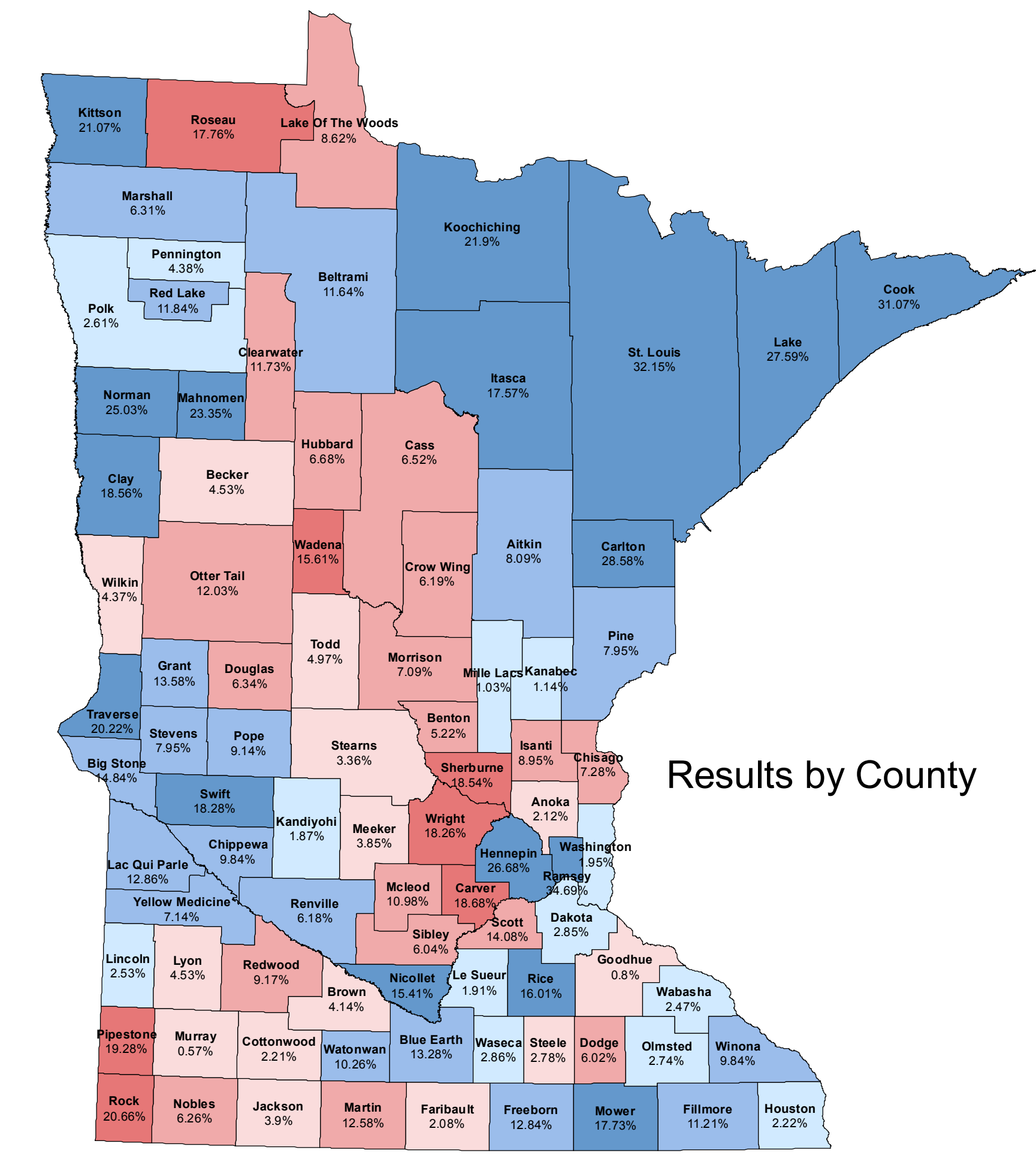
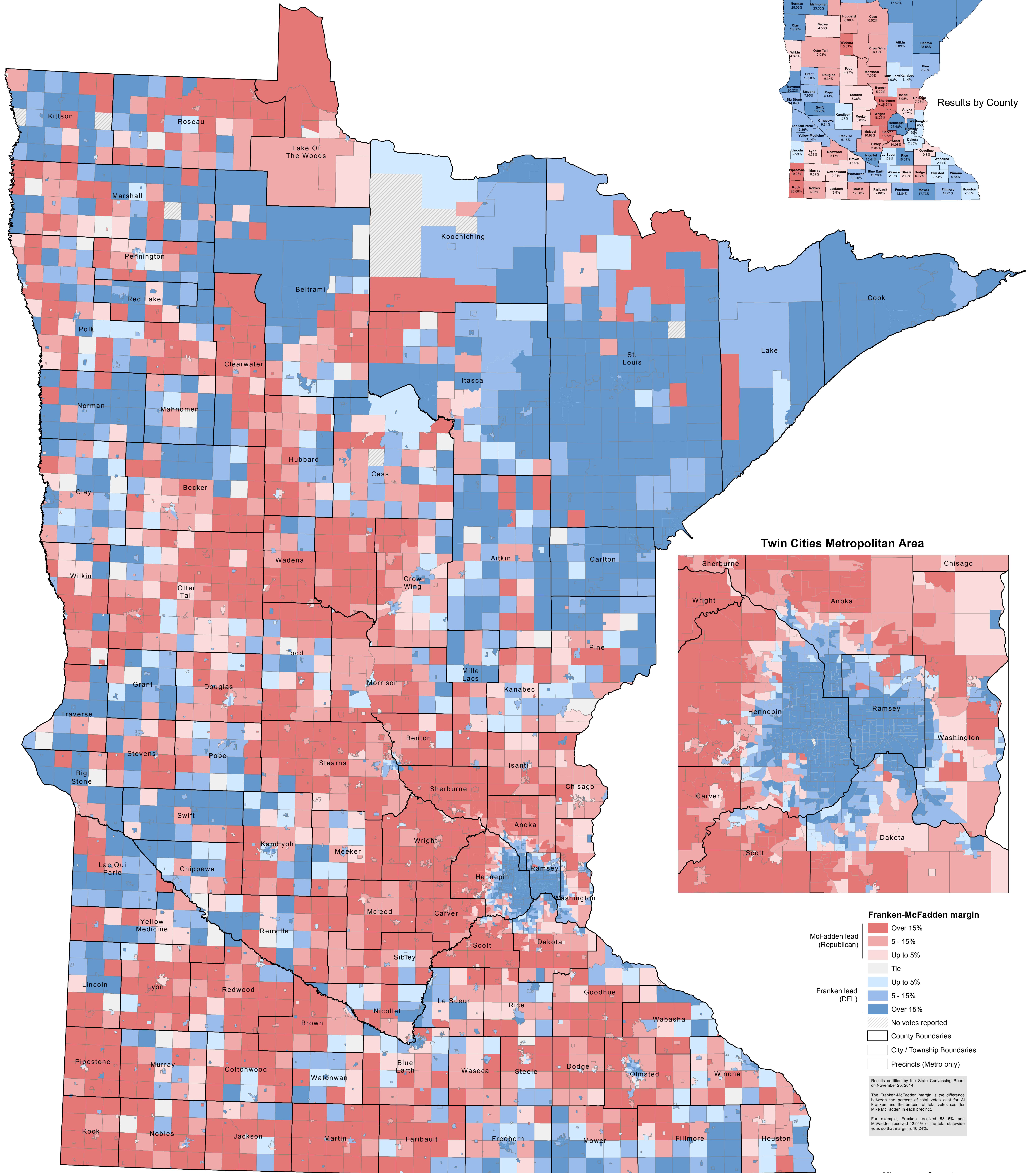


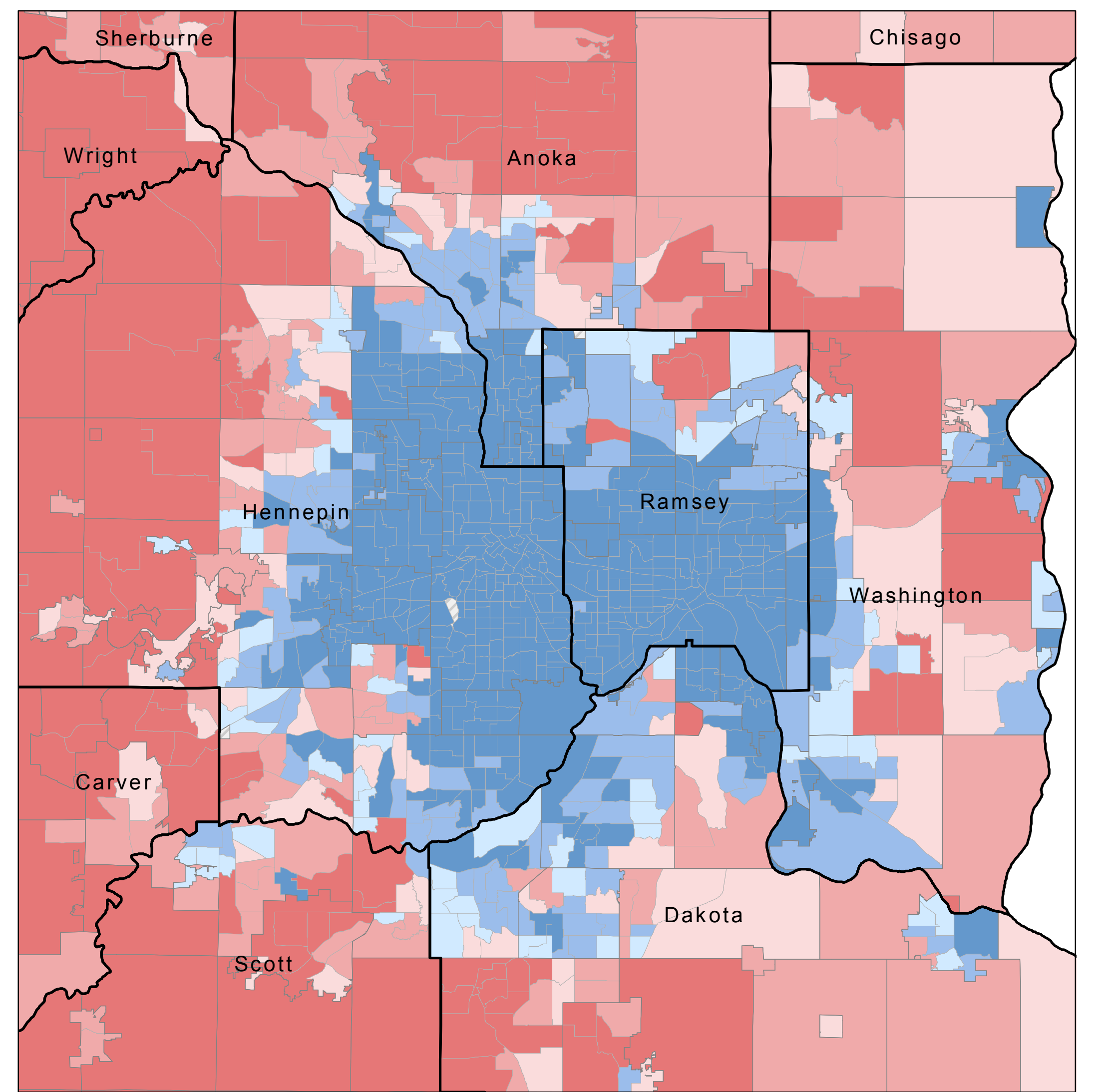

Franken-McFadden margin

Results certified by the State Canvassing Board on November 25, 2014.
 The Franken-McFadden margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for Al Franken and the percent of total votes cast for Mike McFadden in each precinct.
 For example, Franken received 53.15%, and McFadden received 42.91% of the total statewide vote, so that margin is 10.24%.
