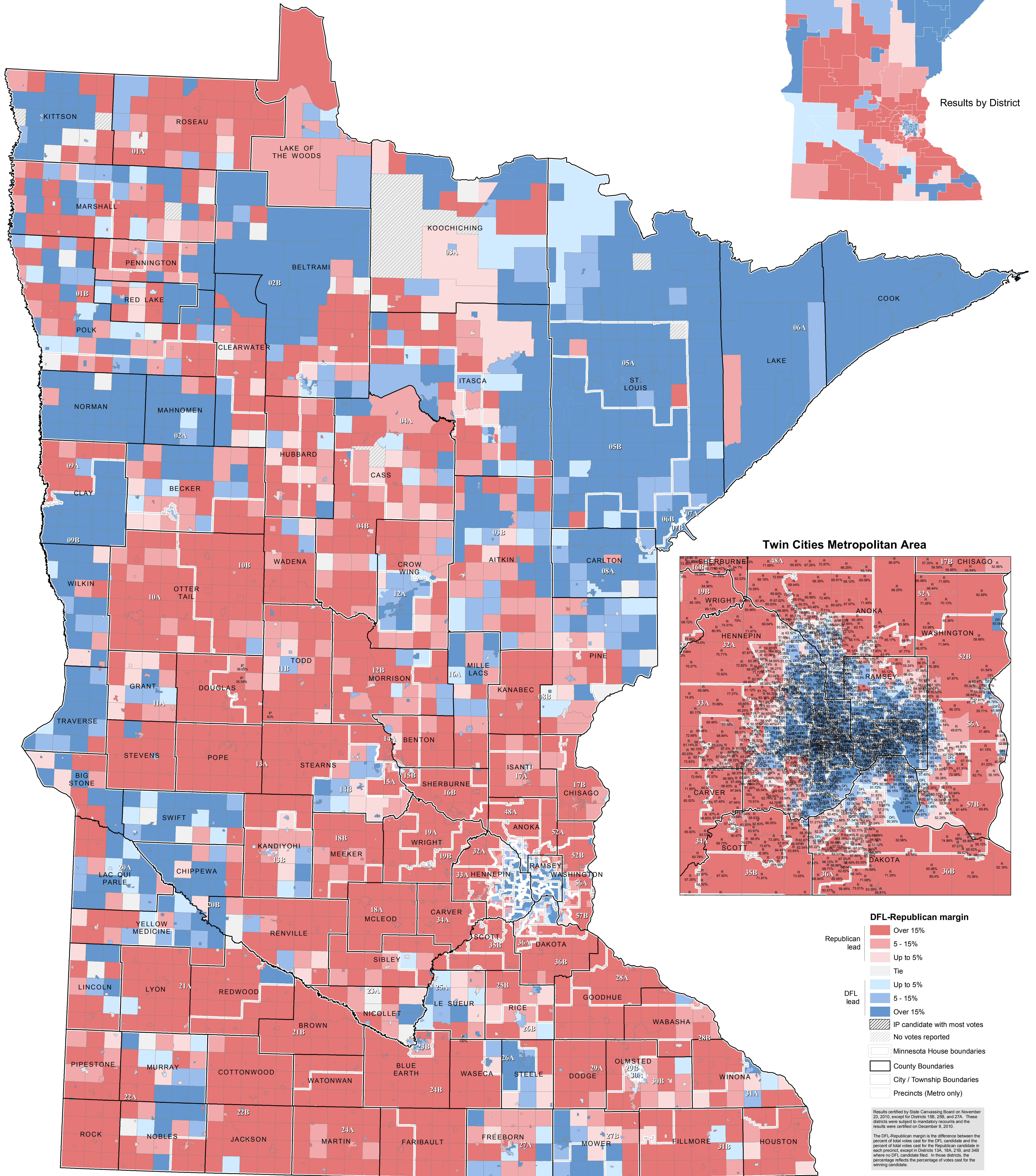


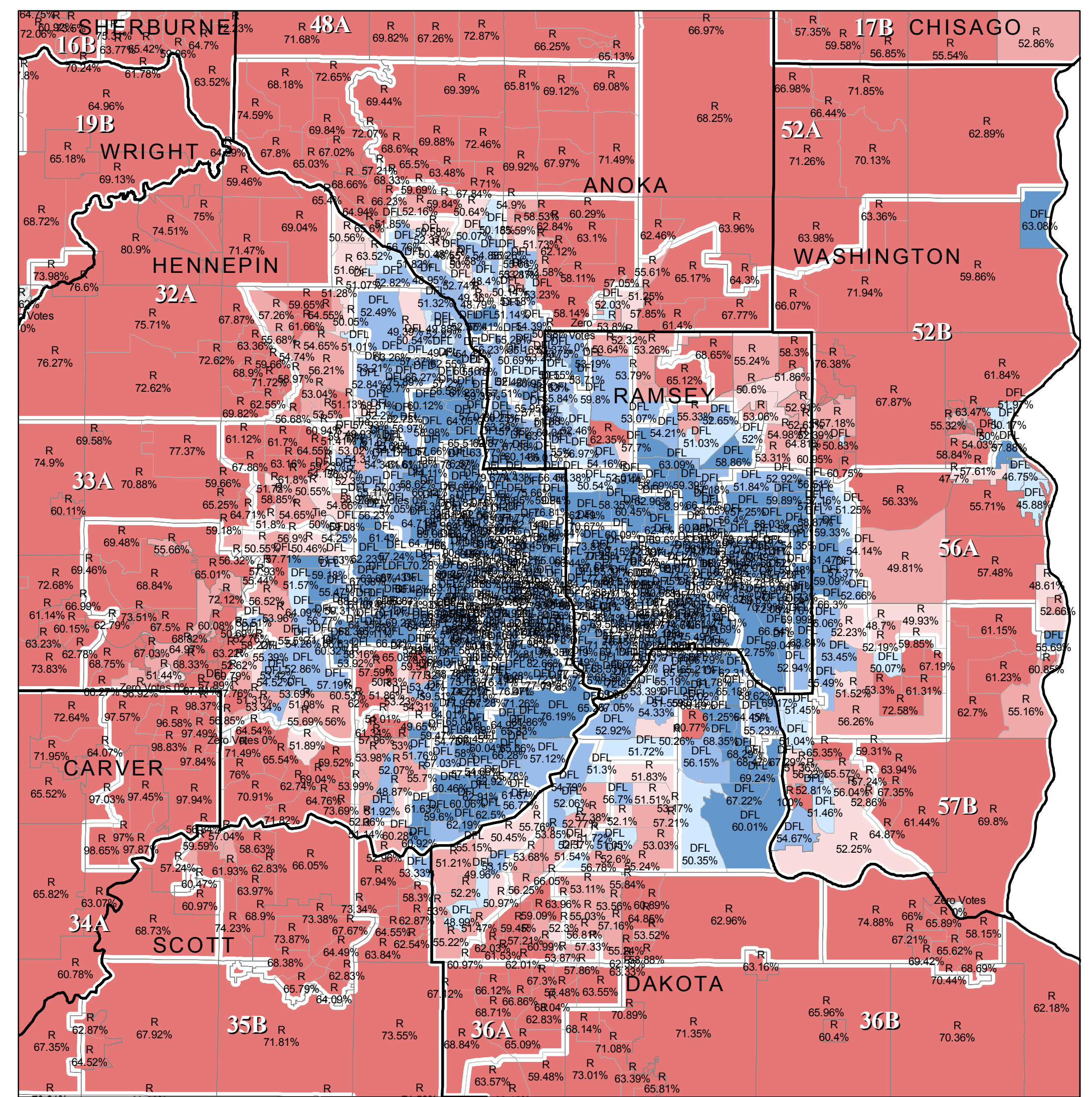

Results certified by State Canvassing Board on November 23, 2010, except for Districts 15B, 25B, and 27A. These districts were subject to mandatory recounts and the results were certified on December 8, 2010.

The DFL-Republican margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for the DFL candidate and the percent of total votes cast for the Republican candidate in each precinct, except in Districts 15A, 18A, 21B, and 34B where no DFL candidate filed. In those districts, the percentage reflects the percentage of votes cast for the winning candidate.
