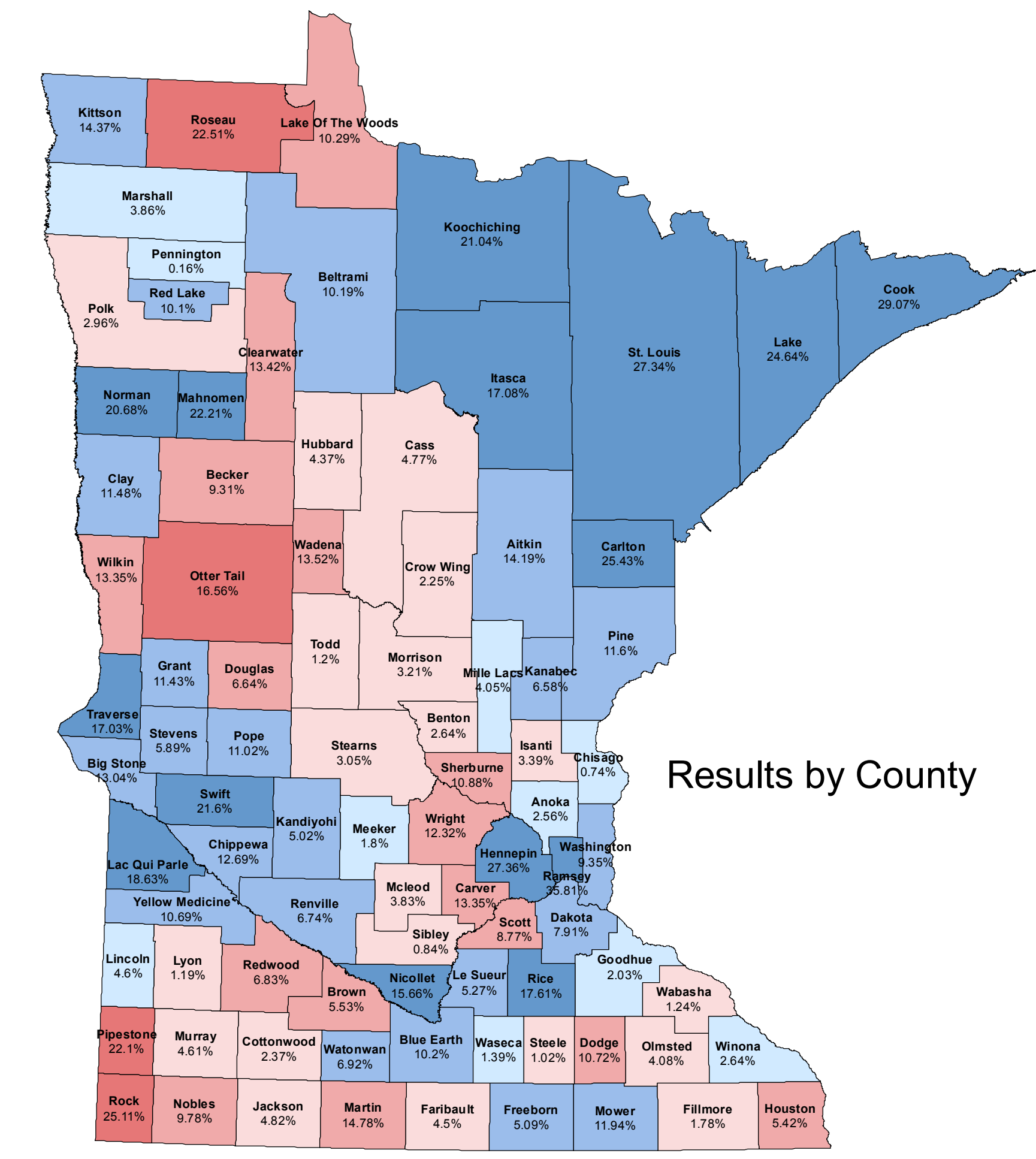
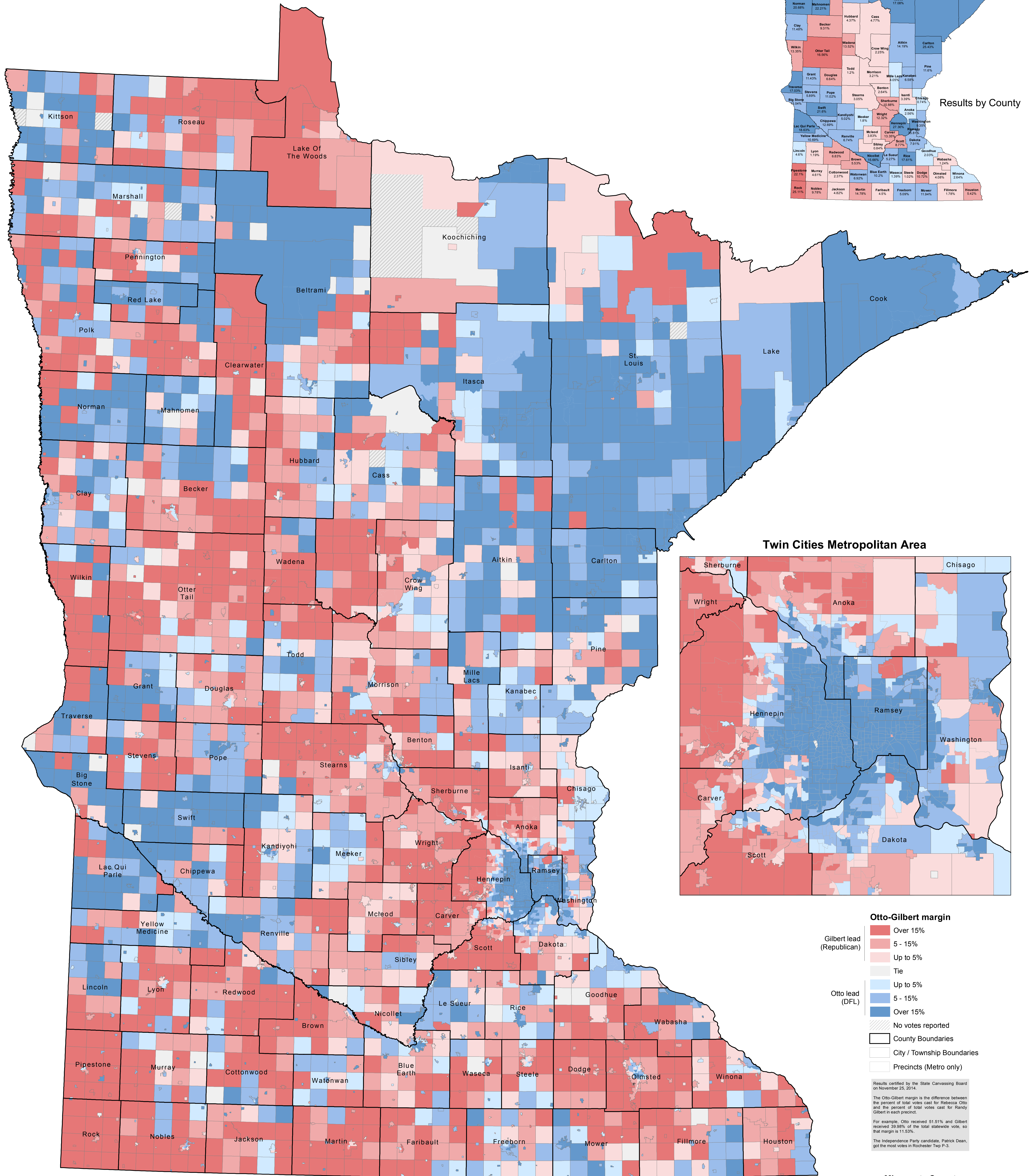


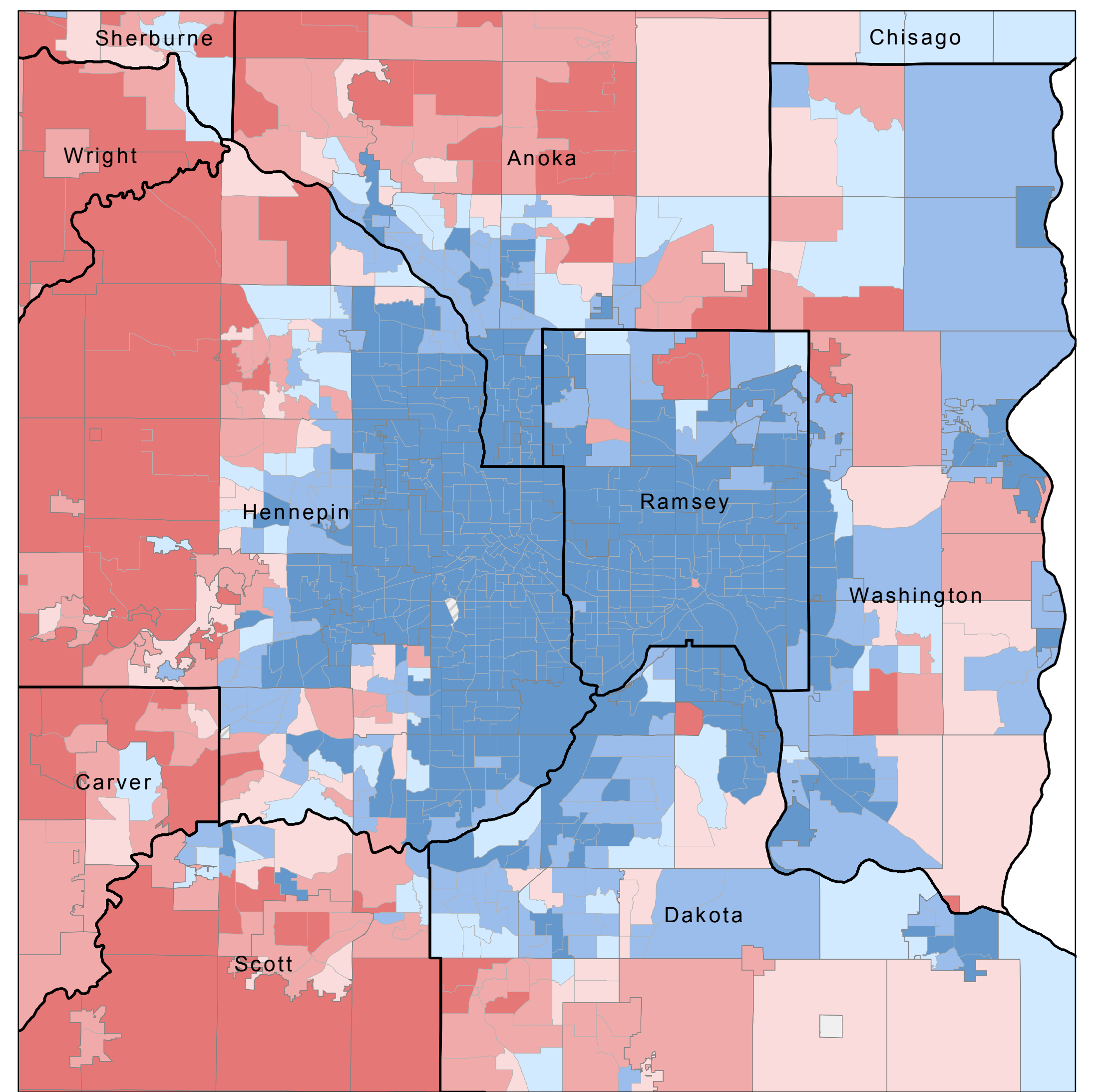

Twin Cities Metropolitan Area

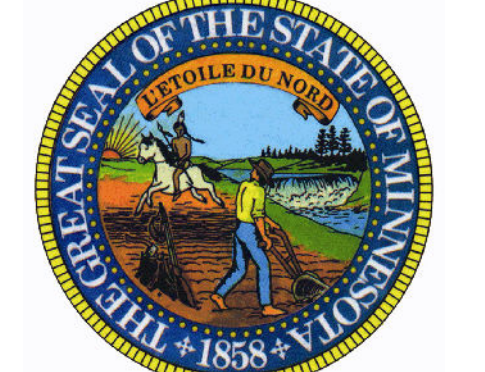


Otto-Gilbert margin

Results certified by the State Canvassing Board on November 25, 2014.
 The Otto-Gilbert margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for Rebecca Otto and the percent of total votes cast for Randy Gilbert in each precinct.
 For example, Otto received 51.51% and Gilbert received 39.98% of the total statewide vote, so that margin is 11.53%.
 The Independence Party candidate, Patrick Dean, got the most votes in Rochester Twp P-3.
