#### Highlights of the Year

We started general construction in June 2016 and were issued a temporary certificate of occupancy in late December 2016.

We hired employees in preparation for our opening on January 12, 2017

We held a pre-opening New Year's Eve party - roughly 400 people attended

Our building attracted new tenants including Mu Performing Arts!

With regard to the period covered by this report, January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016, Can Can Wonderland, SBC pursued the specific benefit purpose stated in its articles in the following ways:

We worked with many different artists and were able to secure the rest of our funding in order to finish the project and open to the public! Our general contractor started in June and we were issued a temporary certificate of occupancy in late December.

The following is a description of how we believe we succeeded in achieving the goals of our specific benefit purpose.

Can Can Wonderland worked with many different artists while working toward getting everything ready to open in 2017. We worked with over 60 artists including mini golf artists, fabricators, photographers, web designer, branding/graphic design, architect, and sculpture.

\$112,492.33 was paid directly to artists.

We created numerous temporary construction jobs, and we created 40 permanent jobs – we hired these positions in late December, and they started training on January 2, 2017.

The following is a description of what prevented us from achieving the specific benefit purpose, to the extent that we did not pursue or create the specific benefit purpose in this reporting year.

We did not open to the public in 2016, but we nearly finished construction in order to be able to open in January 2017.
