MNstarter, SBC was incorporated on September 8, 2016 as a Specific Benefit Corporation under Minnesota's Public Benefit Corporation Act (the "Act"). Pursuant to Section 304A.101 of the Act, specific public benefit purpose as stated in it's Articles of Incorporation is to pursue the specific public benefit purposes of enabling equity crowdfunding campaigns for Minnesota businesses and helping Minnesota residents make informed choices about capital investment.

With regard to the period covered by this report, September 8, 2016 to December 31, 2016, MNstarter, SBC pursued the specific public benefit purpose stated in its articles of incorporation in the following ways:

- Engaged Strommen Software to build and deliver a portal infrastructure that functions pursuant to MNvest legislation.
- Created online channels (<u>www.mnstarter.com</u>, <u>http://www.facebook.com/mnstarter</u>, <u>http://www.twitter.com/mnstarter</u>) to host and deliver educational content and articles regarding intrastate equity and debt crowdfunding in Minnesota.

The following is a description of how we believe we succeeded in achieving the goals of our specific public benefit purpose.

- The portal software infrastructure laid the groundwork for MNstarter to submit the portal software for approval by the Minnesota Department of Commerce in January 2017.
- The online channels continue to grow in traffic and engagement from Minnesota business owners and potential investors.

The following is a description of what prevented us from achieving the specific public benefit purpose, to the extent that we did not pursue or create the specific public benefit in this reporting year.

The Minnesota Department of Commerce requires all MNvest portal operators to submit their portal technology for approval prior to making it available for use. The work done by MNstarter during the period in which this report covers lays the groundwork for this application for approval.
