Since 2013, our company has been part of 231 events with 33,592 attendees in partnership with more than 70 clients, donated nearly \$275,000 of in-kind and cash contributions, directed nearly \$2M worth of business toward other LGBGTQ-, women-, and BIPOC-owned companies, and supported the efforts of raising over \$1.5M for charitable organizations to achieve their important missions!

The following circumstances hindered Events by Lady K GBC's efforts to pursue or create a general public benefit:

Events by Lady K GBC celebrated a milestone of 7 years this year! COVID 19 deeply impacted our industry, and greatly reduced our projected pipeline of projects and actual income. We're fortunate to have established ourselves in the hospitality industry with our unique approach to creating events where every attendee feels welcomed, celebrated, and included. We continue to struggle with adequate cashflow, due to timing of payments, increased costs of doing business, and higher costs of healthcare. We are investigating options for Lines of Credit and investment capital to help us stabilize while continuing our growth. We are hopeful for a better 2021, and are grateful to our client partners, along with federal and regional support to help us weather 2020!
