Annual Benefit Report of Flava Café' A Minnesota General Public Benefit Corporation

March 24th, 2021

Flava Café GBC was incorporated on July 28th, 2020, as a General Benefit Corporation under Minnesota's Public Benefit Corporation Act (the "Act"). Pursuant to Section 304A.101 of the Act, Flava Café's general public benefit purpose as stated in its Articles of Incorporation is:

- **Mission**: Empowering black girls, and gender expansive youth to live intentionally and abundantly. Flava cafe' invests in young womxn by cultivating a culture of community that centers equity, authenticity and sustainability.
- Vision: Flava Café exists to cultivate careers through coffee for young womxn who live at the
 intersections of race, gender, sexuality, and ability. We will eliminate disparities one latte at a
 time.

Our Board of Directors has selected the following independent third-party standard:

B-Lab Impact Assessment (see brief report attached below) in consultation with the independent evaluation consulting firm Coco Canary Consulting, LLC.

Our Board of Directors used the following process to choose our enumerated third-party standard:

The Board, along with co-consultant Coco Canary Consulting, reviewed existing impact assessment tools and discussed the strengths, weaknesses, and costs for each option.

Our Board of Directors determined to use this third-party standard because:

The Board of directors selected the third-party because B-Lab has a proven track record of providing free and/or affordable credible standards and comprehensive performance measurements for social-minded businesses.

The B Corp third-party standard identified and selected by our Board for this report will be used for future annual reports. This third-party standard is being applied in a manner consistent with the third-party standard's application.

With regard to the period covered in this report, July 28^{th,} 2020 to December 31, 2020, Flava Café GBC pursued the general public benefit purpose stated in its Articles of Incorporation and elucidated by the third-party standard in the following ways:

From July 2020 – December 31st, Flava Café was not actively operating or providing goods and/or services to the community. While we did not operate as a business in 2020, our goals for and commitment to the community still remain:

- Flava Café is committed to aiding in the revitalization of historic communities (Rondo and Frogtown) by creating a cultural community staple that will reflect the people, respect the history, honor the land and invest in its youth.
- Flava Café will be an essential model for young women of color to prepare them for career growth and beyond. We also intend to invest in employees through equitable wages, skill development both professionally and personally, as well as through cultural financial planning assistance. At Flava, we seek to enhance the productive participation of women in our economy, secure locally sourced talent, creativity and leadership by ensuring that young women are able to fulfill their dreams.

The following is a description for how we believe Flava Café succeeded in achieving the goals of our specific public benefit purpose:

- Committed to fostering relationships with local community, youth, and research to better communicate our intended social impact for the upcoming crowdfunding campaign in January 2021.
- Incorporated as a General Benefit Corporation under Minnesota's Public Benefit Corporation Act
- Recruited and established a passionate and committed Board of Directors
- Established evaluation plans and models for future annual reviews (logic models, etc.)
- Secured a new location for our business
