

History of Balance Point Strategy

Balance Point Strategy, SBC (BPS) was incorporated as a Minnesota Public Benefit Corporation on April 21, 2017. The founders of BPS share a desire to assist public entities in improving the management and operations of their employee benefit programs. The founders believe that BPS analytical processes and observational model will result in improvements to the management practices in public entities, particularly as it relates to employee benefit programs.

BPS goal is to pursue the specific public benefit purpose of advocating for, and supporting continuous improvement of management and operations in public sector organizations. To this end, BPS focused most of its time during 2022 interacting with potential future ASR Clients.

Pursuit of our Mission

Regarding the period covered by this fifth report, January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022, BPS pursued and achieved the specific benefit purpose stated in its articles of incorporation, and the BPS Founders believe BPS was successful in developing and further refining the *Annual Strategy Review (ASR)* Model working with both Alpha and Beta Clients. This fresh, new, and unique analytical model provides an extensive quantitative review, incorporating data from several, client selected, peer group public school districts. Qualitative analysis for the ASR included measurement of perceptions of employee health plan performance based on stakeholder perspectives and an analysis of the health plan's alignment with the client's overarching strategies and goals.

BPS was able to successfully improve its Annual Strategy Review; testing the methodology; and implementing this methodology in two Minnesota Public School Districts over multiple years' versions of our ASR, resulting in the completion of ASRs affecting the experience of over 2,200 participating employees and 4,400 health plan participants. BPS plans to serve additional public school districts in the future, supporting the continuous improvement of our Public Entity Clients' Employee Health Plans.

BPS founders set no limit on the scope of our work to help public entities improve their management practices. As a result, the founders also donate hundreds of hours mentoring new school district personnel, providing guidance and advice, and assisting Minnesota school districts directly and through various professional organizations.

Beyond the Covid-19 Pandemic, Balance Point Strategy, SBC did not encounter any situations or circumstances that hindered its efforts to pursue and support continuous improvement of management in public sector organizations.
