

Life Reimagined GBC 2023 Secretary of State Annual Report

Life Reimagined GBC was incorporated on February 3rd, 2023 as a General Benefit Corporation under Minnesota's Public Benefit Corporation Act (The "Act") Pursuant to section 304 A 101 of the Act, the general public benefit purpose as stated in its Articles of Incorporation is: To pursue a net material positive impact from the business and operation of a general Benefit Corporation on society, the environment and the well-being of present and future generations.

Life Reimagined mission as stated in the Corporations Articles:

Life Reimagined was established to provide assistance and support to individuals and families navigating the MNsure marketplace for health insurance coverage. Special focus will be given to Underserved Populations/Communities. Groups that have limited or no access to resources or that are otherwise disenfranchised. These groups will include BIPOC, US Born Black Americans and Indigenous communities.

Board of directors selected the following independent third party: MAC Consulting LLC to perform B Corp annual assessment, utilizing B Impact assessment-Performance Good

In accordance with this third-party standard, Life Reimagined GBC has served the general benefit in the following primary ways:

- The Corporation is Latina woman owned and managed.
- The Corporation is located in a marginalized communities and is providing mentorship, skill development and is actively seeking to employ from that community.
- Over 80% of all Life Reimagined GBC clients are from underserved communities

The following is a description of what prevented us from achieving the specific public benefit purpose, to the extent we did not create the specific public benefit in this reporting year:

Life Reimagined GBC experienced a year of growth in 2023 and was able to move to a new facility and is actively seeking to hire its first part-time workers with benefits. The primary obstacle for Life Reimagined GBC faces at this time is raising funding and awareness of its service and the benefits it provides in order to expand its customer base.
