





Results certified by the State Canvassing Board on November 25, 2014.

The Swanson-Newman margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for Lori Swanson and the percent of total votes cast for Scott Newman in each precinct.

For example, Swanson received 52.60%, and Newman received 29.01% of the total statewide vote, so that margin is 13.59%.

Mary O'Connor, the Libertarian Party candidate, received the most votes in Rochester Twp P-3.
