During the third year of operations for Platform Commercial Real Estate, SBC ("Platform") we are proud to have continued to advance our public purpose, which is "to democratize access to real estate development as a driver of community power."

We have provided a number of services that meet that purpose (li and lii).

- Represented a first-time building owner with a goal of preserving a historic office building with dozens of small business tenants and seeking redevelopment opportunities for new housing on the underutilized parking lot.
- Supported a community land trust in multiple site acquisitions and a large-scale master planning effort.
- Provided program development, management and direct technical assistance to multiple nonprofits that advocate for community and cooperative wealth building, economic development and recovery efforts along Lake Street.
- Worked with a supportive housing provider with strategies for commercial ground floor uses in a new development and disposition of a troubled asset.
- Supported a collective of performing arts organizations seeking a stable real estate solution tailored to their needs.
- 6. Worked with four emerging developers through the Minneapolis DTAP program.
- Provided feasibility analysis for a dance organization for an expansion and performance space development project.
- 8. Supported fundraising and pre-development strategy for a BIPOC led emerging developer.
- 9. Represented a BIPOC owned bakery in their first building acquisition.
- 10. Supported the feasibility analysis and site selection for a new shelter serving trans adults.
- Served on the community advisory board for a CDFI lender and provided pro bono training for community organizations seeking to influence redevelopment.

We have not had any significant barriers to achieving our intended benefit in 2025. (1-iii) Platform's Board of Directors consists of Renee Spillum, Erin Heelan, and Marcq Sung. We approved this document via unanimous vote at our Shareholder Meeting on January 22, 2025.
