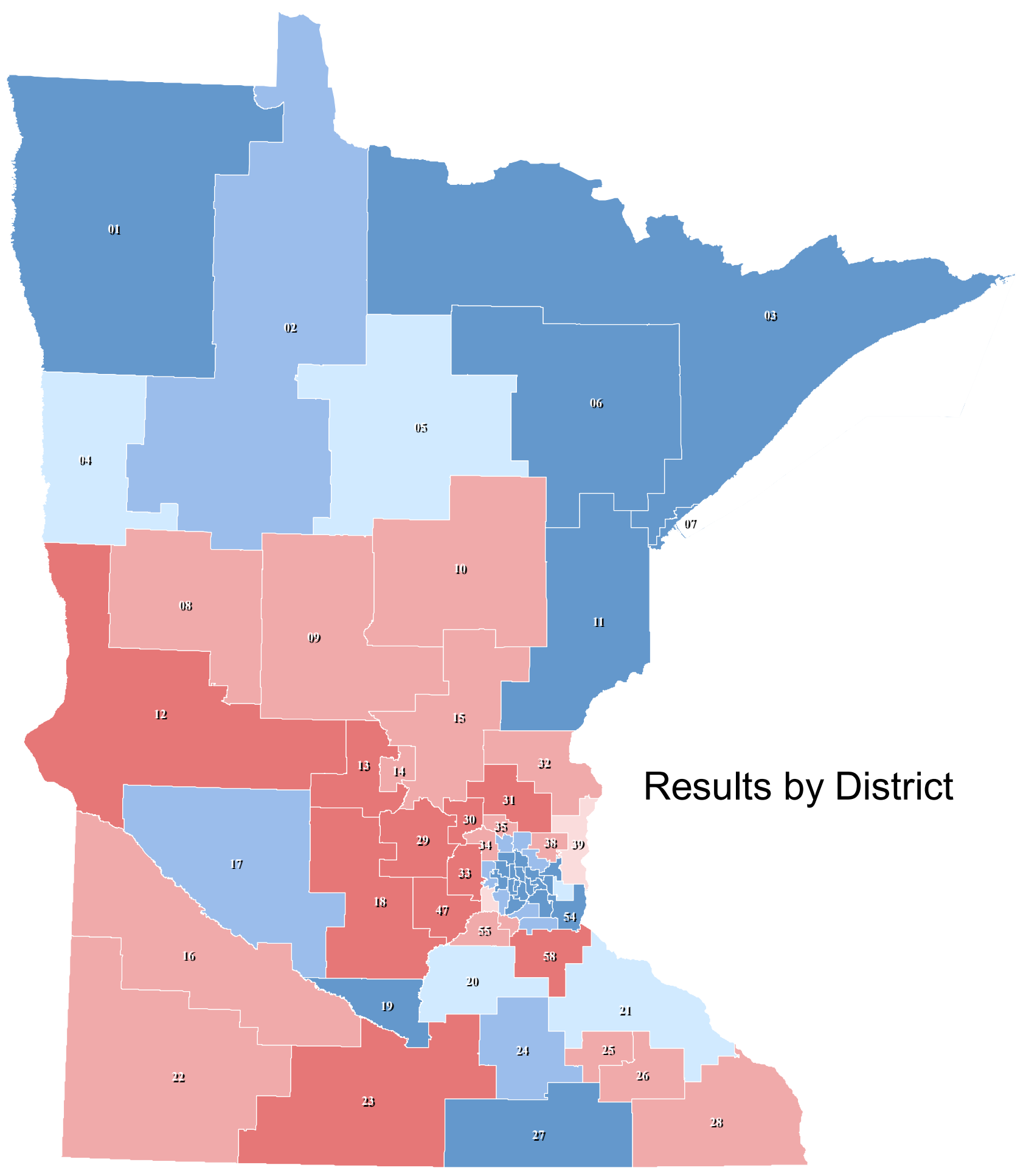
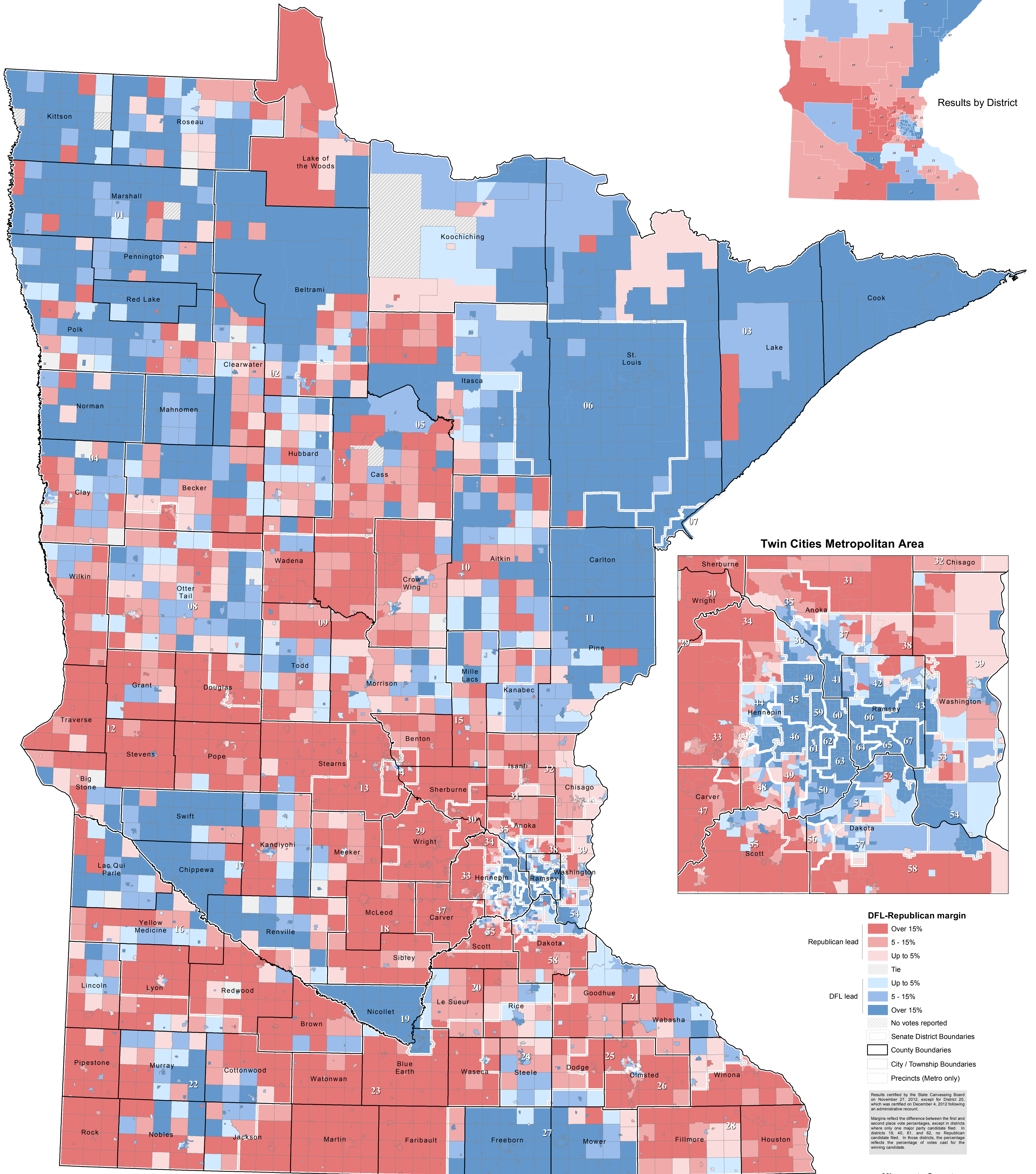


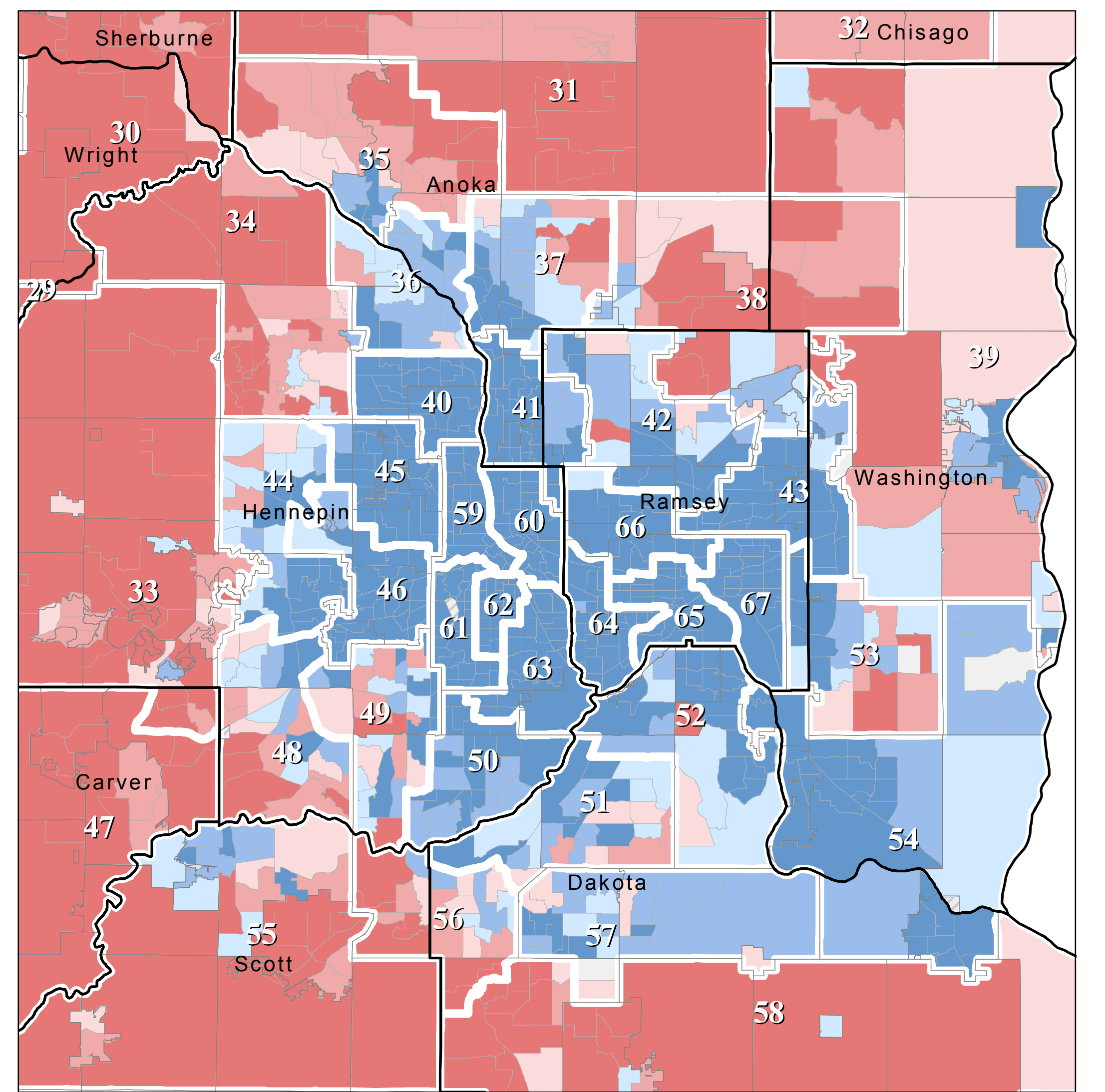

Twin Cities Metropolitan Area



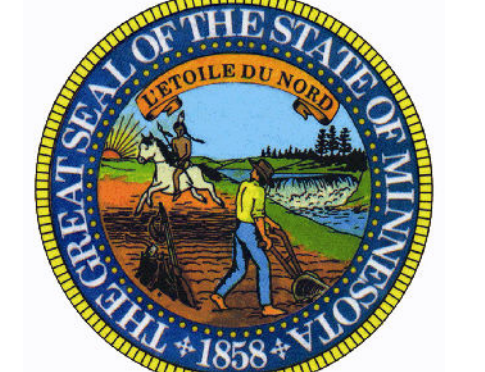
DFL-Republican margin

Results certified by the State Canvassing Board on November 27, 2012, except for District 20, which was certified on December 4, 2012 following an administrative recount.

Margins reflect the difference between the first and second place vote percentages, except in districts where only one major party candidate filed. In districts 19, 40, 61, and 62, no Republican candidate filed. In those districts, the percentage reflects the percentage of votes cast for the winning candidate.
