





Dayton-Johnson margin

Results certified by the State Canvassing Board on November 26, 2014.
 The Dayton-Johnson margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for Mark Dayton and the percent of total votes cast for Jeff Johnson in each precinct.
 For example, Dayton received 50.07%, and Johnson received 44.51% of the total statewide vote, so that margin is 5.56%.
