


2016 General Election Turnout

Total voting as percent of 18+ citizens




Total voting from voting statistics as reported to the State Canvassing Board by county canvassing boards. The estimate of citizens aged 18 and older by county is from the US Census American Community Survey 2014 5-Year Estimates, Citizen Voting Age Population (CVAP).

The statewide percent listed above is the total votes statewide divided by total estimated 18+ citizen population. County average is the average percentage among all 87 counties.

Minnesota's statewide turnout was officially reported as 74.72%, using the eligible voter estimate from the United States Elections Project, which more accurately accounts for all eligibility factors. See <http://www.electproject.org> for details.

Signatures and total voting from voting statistics as reported to the State Canvassing Board by county canvassing boards. Note that counties with high percentages of voting via absentee ballots and/or mail ballots will have relatively low percentages of voting via polling place.

Statewide percent is the total signatures in polling place precincts statewide divided by total votes cast. County average is the average percentage among all 87 counties.
