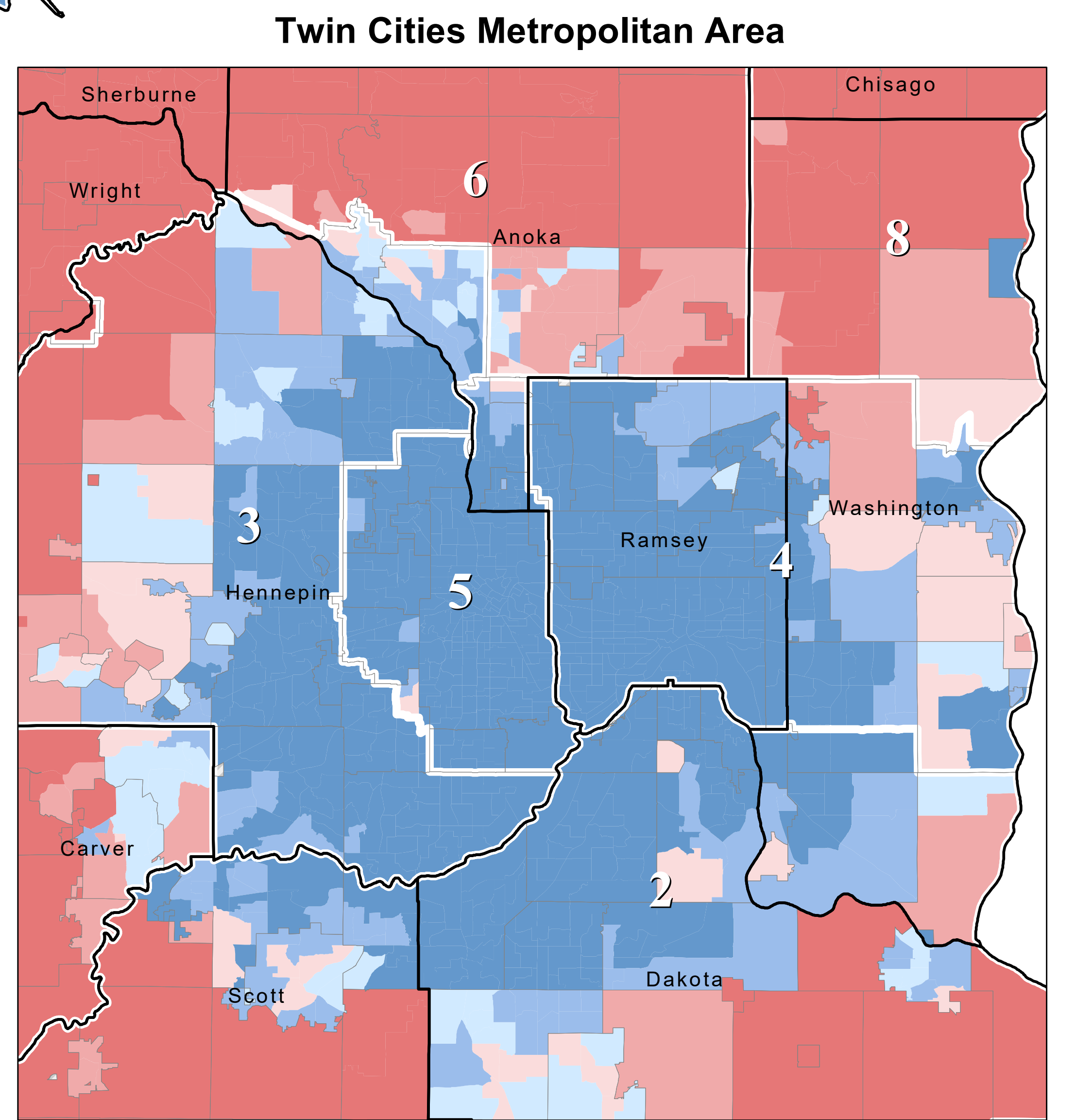
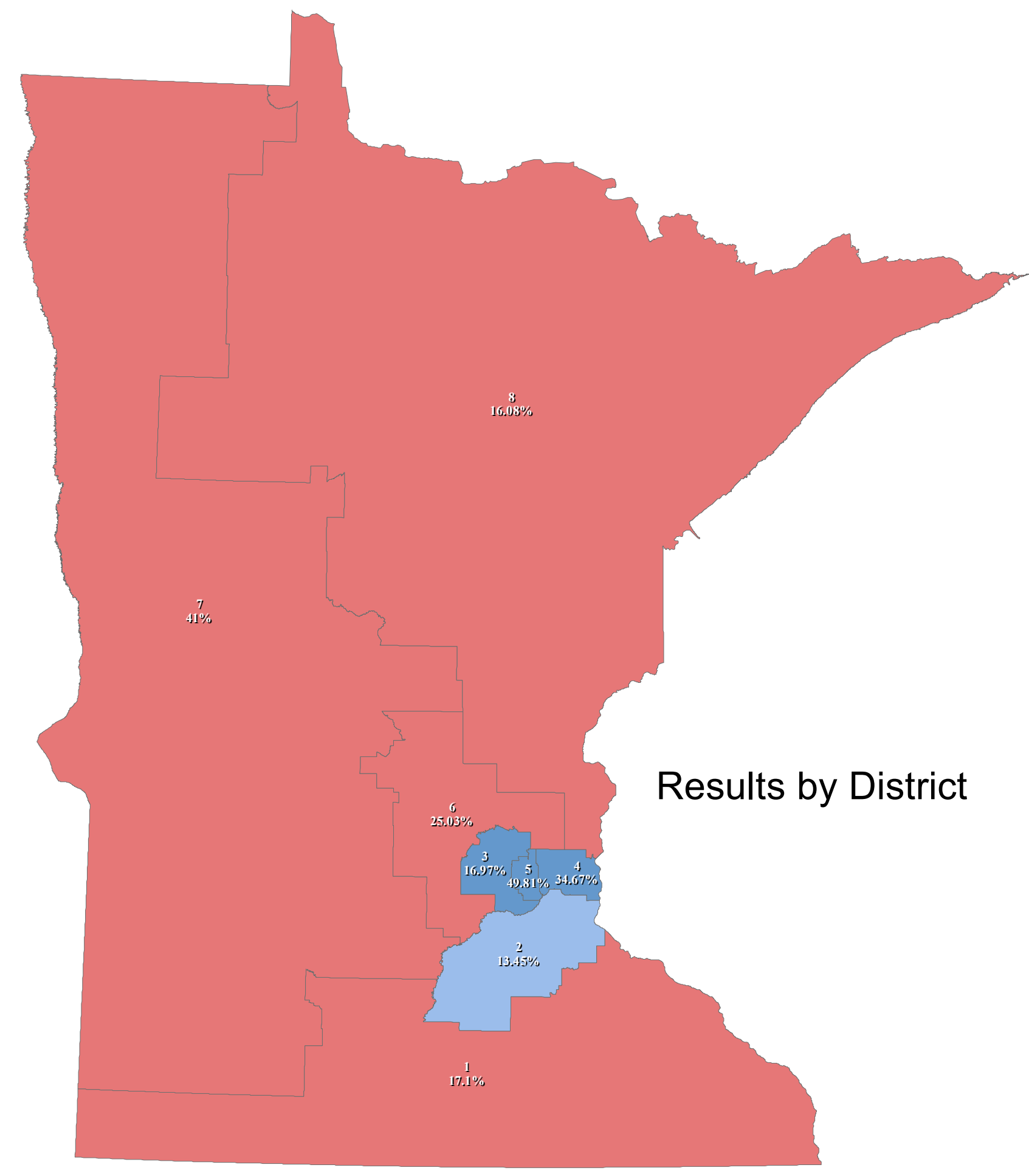
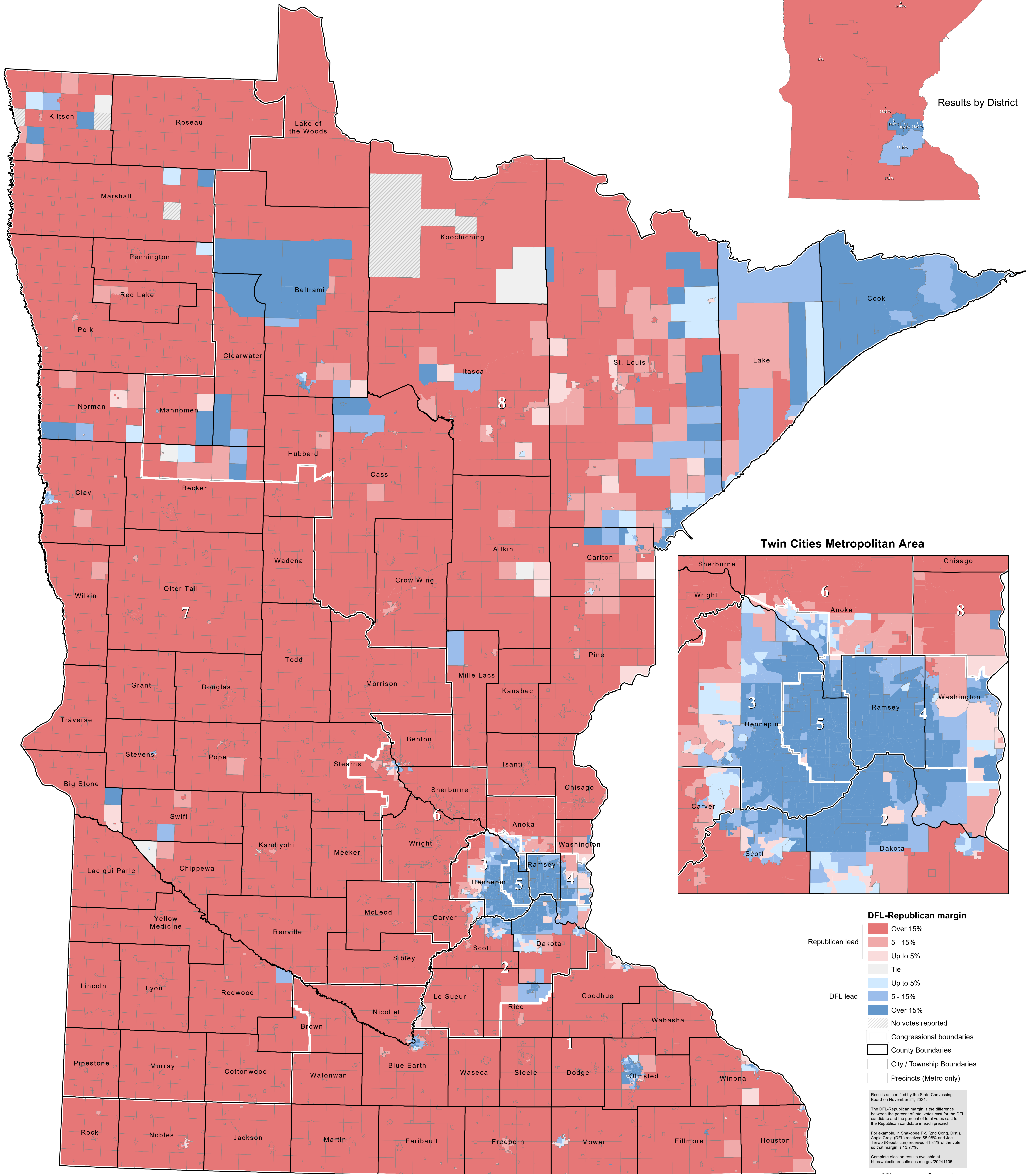


# 2024 General Election for U.S. Representative

## DFL-Republican Margin by Precinct

### Official Results

Results as certified by the State Canvassing Board on November 21, 2024.

The DFL-Republican margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for the DFL candidate and the percent of total votes cast for the Republican candidate in each precinct.

For example, in Shakopee P-5 (2nd Cong. Dist.), Angie Craig (DFL) received 55.08% and Joe Teresi (Republican) received 41.31% of the vote, so that margin is 13.77%.
