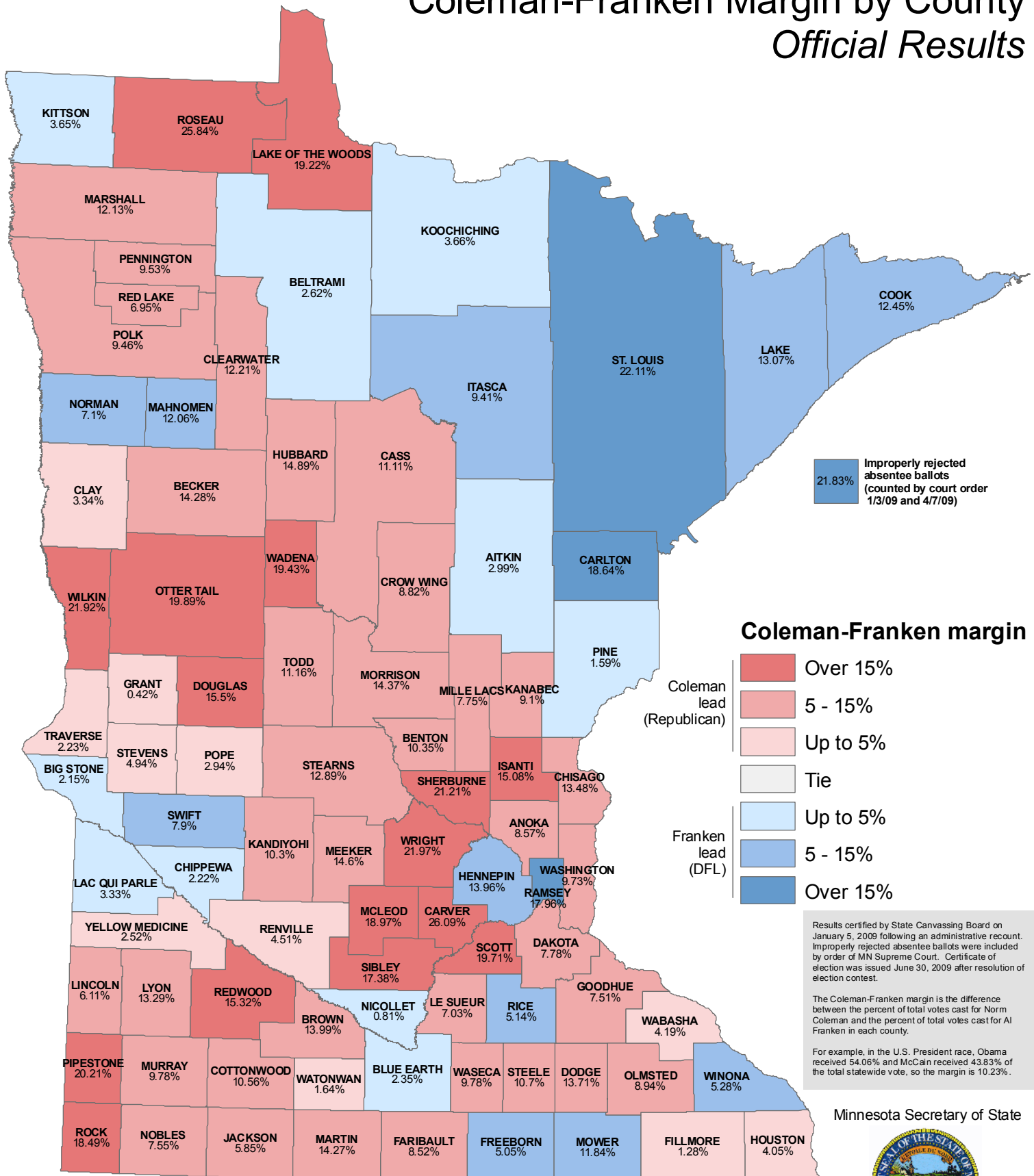


2008 General Election for U.S. Senator

Coleman-Franken Margin by County

Official Results



Results certified by State Canvassing Board on January 5, 2009 following an administrative recount. Improperly rejected absentee ballots were included by order of MN Supreme Court. Certificate of election was issued June 30, 2009 after resolution of election contest.

The Coleman-Franken margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for Norm Coleman and the percent of total votes cast for Al Franken in each county.

For example, in the U.S. President race, Obama received 54.06% and McCain received 43.83% of the total statewide vote, so the margin is 10.23%.
