The Coleman-Franken margin is the difference between the percent of total votes cast for Norm Coleman and the percent of total votes cast for Al Franken in each precinct.

For example, in Hastings W-2 P-2, Coleman received 40.00% and Franken received 40.43% of the total votes in the precinct, so the margin is 0.43%.

*Dean Barkley of the Independence Party received the most votes in ten precincts around the state. Those precincts are labeled "IP" with Barkley's percentage.
