Inspired Spine SBC's mission is to displace the current global standard of care for back pain treatment with its advanced protocols and minimally invasive procedures which have been documented and demonstrated to deliver unparalleled and superior patient outcomes. As stated in Inspired Spine's articles of incorporation, this mission includes delivering this standard of care to the world, starting with the State of Minnesota. In this regard, Inspired Spine devoted substantial resources in 2017 to:

- Inform back pain sufferers about Inspired Spine's superior treatment options via awareness and education campaigns (digital and traditional media), increasing demand for this standard of care by 110% versus 2016;
- Recruit spine surgeons to learn the techniques and commence practicing and refining the corresponding protocols five surgeons commenced training with one surgeon achieving certification proficiency (currently two (2) surgeons are Inspired Spine Certified, including the current Surgeon-Trainer, and five (5) surgeons in various stages of training);
