

Annual Specific Benefit Report of Pivot Interactives SBC



February 14, 2018

This report covers the period from January 1, 2017 until December 31, 2017.

Pivot Interactives SBC was incorporated as a specific benefit corporation on March 18, 2016 by founders Peter Bohacek and Matthew Vonk.

We are in the business of producing video-based science educational resources.

Management:

- Peter Bohacek, Co-Founder and Chief Executive Officer
- Matthew Vonk, Co-Founder, Chief Science Officer, and Chief Financial Officer

Highlights of the Year:

- We received 3 grants and awards in 2017 totaling over \$650k.
- We produced many new videos in new subject areas of physics
- We made excellent progress toward the development of many new features for our proprietary video player
- We established and maintained relationships with national distributors of educational resources.
- We started selling subscriptions to the platform and currently have more than 5000 paid subscribers.

1 i) What are ways that the corporation has pursued and created the specific public benefit stated in its articles?

The specific benefit stated in our articles is as follows:

Producing and developing innovative educational video-based resources which enhance and deepen learning about the sciences by enabling students to interact with video content.

We have "pursued and created" that specific benefit in a number of ways. First, we have produced many new physics-related videos in the subject areas of electricity and magnetism, optics, chemistry, and mechanics. In addition, we are in the process of developing a number of new functionalities for our proprietary video-player. These new features include user uploadable videos and peer-to-peer sharing for instructors.

In order to help students, however, it is not sufficient to produce excellent resources. In addition, we need to make instructors aware of our products and then educate them on how to use the resources. We are also in the process of pursuing both of those tasks.

1 ii) To what extent has the specific public benefit purpose been pursued and created?

We are a small company that is less than two years old. We have few material resources and only a small number of personnel resources (including both employees and contractors). That said, we made great progress on our specific public benefit during 2017. As mentioned above we have produced many new videos, added many new features, improved the design and usability of our resources, and worked closely with our distribution partners to get our educational materials in instructor's hands.

1 iii) Discuss any circumstances that have hindered efforts to pursue or create the specific benefit:

Like any new company, we have faced challenges (primarily not enough time and not enough money). That said, we have still been able to create the specific benefit.
