Living Ark SBC operated a sober house for recovering alcoholics and addicts. Our specified benefit is assisting in alcohol and addiction recovery.

While our profits in 2020 are approximately \$2000, our corporate lifetime operation is still operating at a loss. In spite of this situation, in 2020 we donated \$600 to Rys Hope, a charitable organization that helps alcoholics and addicts get started in sober homes with a donation to cover some initial costs before they are able to have employment income.

Living Ark SBC also hosted several dinners and holiday celebrations to help subsidize the food costs of the members and to build their morale. In addition, Living Ark SBC held a Christmas gathering and gave presents to all members.

Throughout the year, Living Ark SBC gives T-shirts to new members with the Living Ark logo, which is not completely a charitable gift because the logo may have advertising value, but we do not seriously believe we will ever get a new resident because of the T-shirt, and never have. The purpose is to help our residents develop pride in what they are doing. Some members are very proud of the shirt and the recovery program it represents.

This year, we have helped new members find employment and transportation to work. There are specific cases in which we have directly obtained felony-friendly jobs for the hard-to-employ, including one person with a felony and who had never had a job before. We have arranged though friendly contacts in the AA/NA community to get rides to work for members when it is too far to bike, or too challenging and unsafe in the winter.

Living Ark SBC works with its members to promote community service, to each other, to other addicts and alcoholics, and to the general community. The members have responding very well, with activities including helping AA clubs set up tables and sanitize for covid 19. They are also helping each other with car repairs, and voluntarily covering for household chores for others when they have a family crisis.
