The board of directors of the corporation has identified B Impact Assessment as its third party standard for evaluation of its general benefit. The B Impact Assessment was developed by B Lab, which is independent of the corporation, its board of directors, and its officers. The board of directors of the corporation has approved the corporation's report for the year ended December 31, 2021.

Under the B Impact Assessment, the corporation has determined that it has served the general benefit in the following primary ways:

- The corporation is black-woman owned and managed;
- The corporation provides employment, mentoring, and skill development to teens, young adults, and individuals returning to the community following incarceration in an economically challenged community;
- The corporation serves an underserved community and works with racially diverse vendors and other service providers in its community.
- The corporation provides a venue for communication and healing following racial tensions following the events of the summer of 2020.

The corporation's efforts to pursue general benefit were not materially hindered during 2021. The management of the corporation has worked to overcome standard business challenges related to financing its development and delays in facility build out.
